壹、申論題:

- 一、中譯英:請將以下兩段中文翻譯成正確、通順、達意的英文句子。
 - ○警察在路上攔截交通,搜查可疑的車輛。

擬答: Police intercepted traffic on the roads and searched for suspicious vehicles.

(二)酒駕是目前臺灣交通肇事之首因。去年,約四百人因此而喪生。

擬答: Driving under the influence is the primary cause of traffic accidents in Taiwan. There were 400 people killed by drunk driver last year.

二 英文作文:

提示:根據調查結果顯示,在一般民眾心中,警察是份危險的工作,因為警察在執行公務時,意外狀況太多,難以掌握。請寫一篇文長約 200 字的短文描述警察工作可能遇到的危險,以及你認為該有的應變之道。

擬答:

Law enforcement officers face a multitude of dangers in their everyday duties today that rival the threat of getting shot or injured. For example, foot/vehicle pursuits, responding "CODE 3" (lights and siren) (註), making an arrest, traffic control, the burden of equipment and biohazard exposure, etc.

In order to cope with the above-mentioned hazards police may face, some actions could be taken to prevent possible injury or loss of life of police officers.

First of all, if officers are exposed to these dangers on a daily basis, they should wear ballistic vests and heavy leather belts containing batons, pepper spray, handcuffs, a radio and a handgun.

Furthermore, working at night is generally more dangerous than working during the day, as criminality is more predominant during the evening hours. Improvements in equipment and training and better emergency medical care have led to a decrease in the danger of being a police officer.

Last but not least, one of the most dangerous aspects of police work is pursuit driving or responding "CODE 3." Under these circumstances, not only do the officers have to be in control of their own vehicle, they must be fully aware of the traffic surrounding them.

Police are about three times as likely to be killed on the job as the average American. We should do what we can to diminish the threat to police officers, but not at the expense of the rights and safety of everyone else. Striking the right balance requires a proper assessment of just what sorts of risks police officers actually face. (259 字)

備註: CODE 3: Life-threat response. Emergency traffic, or simultaneous use of lights and siren required in order to achieve a rapid response. In most circumstances this does not allow the responding unit to ignore jurisdictional traffic laws or operate without due regard to safety. It does however give the authority to request the right-of-way from other vehicles on the roadway.

Azamat Tazhayakov and Dias Kadyrbayev, who both came to the US from Kazakhstan, were charged with conspiring to <u>53.</u> justice by concealing and destroying evidence. Robel Philipos, who graduated from a Cambridge, Massachusettes, high school with Tsarnaev, was charged with lying to investigators about the visit to Tsarnaev's room. According to FBI <u>54.</u>, just hours after surveillance camera photos of the Boston Marathon suspects were flashed around the world on April 18, Tsarnaev's friends <u>55.</u> he was one of the bombers and removed the backpack along with a laptop from Tsarnaev's room at the university of Massachusetts at Dartmouth.

在出庭時,Kazakh 的學生並沒有要求交保且將繼續羈押直到 5 月 14 日的 聽審。 An emergency call comes in about a possible bomb in lower Manhattan and an alert pops up on computer screens at the New York Police Department, instantly showing officers an interactive map of the neighborhood, footage from nearby security cameras, whether there are high radiation levels and whether any other threats have been made against the city. In a click, police know exactly what they're getting into.

Such a hypothetical scenario may seem like something out of a futuristic crime drama, but the technology is real, developed in a partnership between America's largest police department and Microsoft Corp., and the latest version has been quietly in use for about a year. The project could pay off in more ways than one: The NYPD could make tens of millions of dollars under an unprecedented marketing deal that allows Microsoft to sell the system to other law enforcement agencies and civilian companies around the world. The city will get a 30 percent cut.

The Domain Awareness System, known as the dashboard, gives easy access to the police department's voluminous arrest records, emergency calls, more than 3,000 security cameras citywide, license plate readers and portable radiation detectors — data that raises privacy concerns for some civil liberties groups. But the dashboard system mines existing tools and doesn't create any new surveillance.

Right now, it is used only in NYPD offices, mostly in the counterterrorism unit. Eventually, the system could supply crime-fighting information in real time to officers on laptops in their squad cars and on mobile devices while they walk the beat.

區域警戒系統(Domain Awareness System, DAS),又稱為控制面板,使警察部門得輕易取得大量的逮捕紀錄、緊急電話、全市超過 3000 支監視錄影、車牌識讀器及可攜式輻射探測器等——而民間自由團體則對該系統所提供之資訊關注個人隱私問題。但該控制面板系統會與現有之系統結合,並不會產生任何新的管制(監視)。

目前該系統僅在紐約市警局的辦公室使用,大多數都用在反恐單位。最後,該系統能夠全天候提供員警於警車上的筆電及勤區巡邏時所攜帶的 行動設備有關打擊犯罪的資訊。
